Local Agencies for Outpatient Services

- Only for adolescents, but they can remain linked there until they are 21 years old
- Psychiatrists on site, but clients must be linked with a counselor as well
- Accept numerous types of insurance, both public and private

Intake is through a central system. You MUST call 1-877-448-4466. They will either schedule an appointment for you or instruct you to come to walk –in hours: Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday between 10:00am-11:00am. They will ask you to arrive at 9:30am to complete paperwork first

Local Practices for Outpatient Services

- Collection of various providers: social workers, psychologists, psychiatrists and psychiatric nurse practitioners (both of whom can prescribe medication), mental health counselors and others
- The Practice may or may not take public insurance/third party reimbursement, such as Managed Medicaid, Child Health Plus, etc.
- Each provider may accept different insurances
- Each provider may vary in their treatment of adolescents, adults or both
- Websites typically include biographies of all providers, where it may indicate with what age range they work, what they may specialize in and whether or not they are accepting new clients
- May have multiple sites, so be sure the provider you are considering works closer to Tonawanda

Check Your Health Insurance Website/Provider Manual

- You can obtain a list of providers covered by your insurance. Start with Mental Health or Behavioral Health. Some website then have filters, where you can search by specialty areas, such as anxiety, trauma, grief, etc.
- You can contact your child's school counselor or social worker, who may be able to provide suggestions based on your options

Counseling Assistance Program of Tonawanda (CAP-T)

- Outpatient mental health services, provided by Best Self Behavioral Health, at the high school
- Only available Thursday 8:00am-5:00pm and Friday 8:00am-3:00pm
- Limited spots are available and there may be a wait list
- Priority is given to families with transportation issues, however elementary students need to be transported to appointments by families

Crisis Intervention

- Available 24 hours/day
- Used for phone consultation
- Can conduct home visits to assess safety and determine if evaluation at the hospital is necessary

CARES: Crisis and Re-Stabilization Emergency Services

Emergency Evaluation/ Inpatient Services

- Available 24/day
- Conduct evaluations at their hospital to assess safety and determine if admission to the psychiatric unit is necessary
- Present at the emergency room and indicate you are seeking a psychiatric evaluation
